Ardgowan House, Castle and Gardens is a magnificent 76 room privately owned stately home on the West coast of Scotland, steeped in history and tradition.

Remarkably, Ardgowan has remained in the possession of one family – the Shaw Stewarts – since 1404, having passed through 27 successive generations.

While Ardgowan House is not open to the public, the present day custodians Sir Ludovic and his wife Lady Shaw Stewart greatly enjoy welcoming privately arranged group tours into their home – affording their guests a rare glimpse into the grandeur, realities, and occasional absurdities, of life in "Scotland's most beautiful private house".

Tours are personally guided by Sir Ludovic, who counts among his direct ancestors both King Robert the Bruce and Pocahontas. As a former art dealer and now a historian, writer and storyteller, Sir Ludovic weaves together a tale of family lore, scandal, romance, intrigue and mystery – embedding the fascinating narrative of Ardgowan through the centuries within the larger sweep of Scotland's electrifying history.

Following the house tour, guests will be introduced to Scotland's national instrument – the Bagpipes. Under the expert guidance of our friendly Pipe Master, you'll learn about its colourful history, enjoy a lively demonstration and even have a once in a lifetime opportunity to try and recreate its distinctive sound!
